







Singular Sensation

Nikki Giovanni's A Good Cry: What We Learn from Tears and Laughter. The latest publication from the American poet is a personal account of life's ups and downs told through her sharp lens.



In a microwave-safe bowl, combine 1 bag (12 oz) orange candy melts and 2 tsp vegetable shortening. Microwave 1 minute, then stir. Continue microwaving in 30-second increments, stirring each time, until melted. With a fork, dip 48 unsalted mini pretzels into melted candy one by one, allowing excess to drip back into bowl, and place on a parchment-lined baking sheet. Add green candy-coated sunflower seeds as stems and refrigerate 15 minutes to set. Transfer to an airtight container. Pretzels will keep at room temperature for up to 2 weeks.
